



1 Bobbin Bag

Materials needed:

Pair of 10mm knitting needles
1 Bobbin of Hooplayarn of any colour

To Make:

This bag is made using 3 simple stitch patterns

Garner Stitch - Knit each row

Stocking Stitch - Knit 1 row, purl next row and repeat this pattern

Moss Stitch - Knit 1, purl 1 and repeat to end of row. Begin next row with the same stitch that you finished the previous row (e.g. if first row ends on knit then start next row with knit and then purl, knit purl etc to end)

Cast on 22 stitches

2. Knit 1 row in Moss Stitch

3. Moss Stitch 1st 7 stitches, cast off 8 stitches and Moss Stitch to end

4. Moss Stitch 1st 7 stitches, cast on 8 stitches and Moss Stitch to end

5. Moss Stitch 5 rows

6. For the body of the bag you can either just knit or purl or a combination to give a more varied pattern but continue until your work measures approx 30cm

7. Moss Stitch 5 rows

8. Moss Stitch 1st 7 stitches, cast off 8 stitches and Moss Stitch to end

9. Moss Stitch 1st 7 stitches, cast on 8 stitches and Moss Stitch to end

10. Knit 1 row in Moss Stitch

11. Cast off

To Finish:

Finish off by sewing the Hooplayarn bag by folding it in half with the right sides facing inwards and sewing or crocheting the 2 open ends together and weaving in any loose ends. Turn the bag the right way round.

You can personalise your bag further by embellishing with flowers or trinkets – whatever takes your fancy!
