CROCHET PATTERN

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## Easy Cupcake

Designed by Linda Ulfsparre Sewell

### Materials needed:

9mm crochet hook

Oddments of Hooplayarn - 3 colours

Stitch marker or a piece of contrasting yarn to mark the beginning of a round

### To Make:

You need to be able to make Magic ring - mr, chain - ch, double crochet - dc, slip stitches - ss and invisible decreases or dc2tog

### Bottom of cupcake:

With base colour, make magic ring, then make 1 ch. Crochet 6 dc in ring, draw tight, place stitch marker in last stitch. (Don't make a slip stitch to join into a ring, just continue next round and work in a continuous spiral).

Next round: \* 2 dc in every dc\*, repeat 6 times (total 12 dc).

Next round: crochet through back loops only, 1 dc in every dc (12 dc).

Next round: crochet through both loops, 1 dc in every dc (12 dc). Repeat this round twice (this gives you a cupcake that is totally 4 rounds high). Make 2 ss to finish off the base and cut off Hooplayarn.

### Icing:

Join Icing colour, crochet through front loops only: \*1dc in dc, 2 dc in dc\* repeat 6 times until end of round (18 dc).

Next round: Crochet through both loops, one dc in every dc to end of round (18 dc).

Next round: \*1 dc, dc2tog\*, repeat 6 times until end of round (12 dc).

Next round: \*dc2tog\*, repeat until only a small hole remains (approximately 4 times), cut off Hooplayarn leaving long tail, thread through all stitches and draw tight.

### Decoration:

With final colour, make magic ring, then 1 ch. Crochet 5 dc in ring, join into a ring with ss, take off Hooplayarn and leave long tail to stitch cherry to top of cupcake.
